Summer Season

As you know ArcheryGB suspended archery and the range and field were then closed by BP.

Archery GB has made the following statement, although it does not say when the 48hour period started- maybe yesterday, 11th May.

“In line with government guidelines regarding COVID-19, we are advising that all archery in the UK is postponed in the UK. We are finalising plans for the first phase of the safe return to archery, we are expecting further clarification from the Department for Digital, Culture, Media & Sport (DCMS) within the next 48 hours, and will aim to communicate the next steps as soon as it is practicable to do so. We appreciate your patience during this time.”

I have contacted Meadhurst/BP to see what their plans are for access to the range They are monitoring advice from governing bodies and will then consider their next move.

We will let you know as soon as we know it is possible to recommence shooting, and what restrictions and limitations will be imposed.

Archery GB has emailed all members today (after I completed this Newsletter) with an update.
