# Club Championship-6<sup>th</sup> August

The Club Championship is a York round (100/80/60) for men and a Hereford (80/60/50) for ladies. That is 6 dozen at the longest distance, 4 dozen at the middle distance and 2 dozen at the short distance. Juniors shoot equivalent rounds at shorter distances according to their age.

Those who cannot reach the distances may shoot shorter distance equivalent rounds.

Sighters will be at 10am. Please arrive by 9.30am

In the afternoon, with sighters at 1pm, others may join in to take part in the 6 dozen round. Long National (80/60y), National (60/50y), Short National (50/40y), Junior National (40/30y) or Short Junior National (30/20y). This may suit newer archers who might find 12 dozen daunting.

Everyone who takes part in any round and who has a handicap is competing for the Handicap Championship which takes place simultaneously. As long as you have shot 3 round and submitted the scores to the Records Officer, you will have a Handicap. There is still time to obtain a handicap, if you don't have one, by shooting short rounds in the evening perhaps or a longer round at the weekend. All rounds count as long as the score has been witnesses and signed by another archer.

As well as the Championship and handicap championship, there is also Novice Cup to be awarded. This is for archers who have started archery in the past year, since the 2016 Championship.
